





# Safety & Security

#### Clean Car Campaign

  - Filing a report provides statistics that impact prioritization, funding, patrol presence, etc!

# Finance Report

#### As of 11/4/20:

- Started this year with \$23,222 in the bank.
- Currently \$24,691 in the bank vs \$23,936 the same day last year.
- A large portion of our revenue arrives between November – January.
- Residential Membership Revenue: \$18,226 YTD vs \$17,150 LYTD
- No more business membership revenue.
- Majority of Membership Revenue Funds:
  - Security Patrol
  - Park Maintenance
  - Property Taxes, Insurance, Solid Waste
  - Website/Membership Software

## Membership Report

- 121 Residential Household Members (192 people):
  - Regular memberships are up
  - Senior memberships are down
  - 3 Apartment renter members room to grow!
- Membership Drive in October
  - Thank you, Street Captains!
  - 14 New Members!
